This state-of-the-art winery received an award for its unique modern design. The facility uses its steep hilltop property for gravity-flow winemaking, where wine flows from one level to another without using a mechanical pump. The facility achieves this wine process through the structure's tiered design and energy-efficient butterfly roof, designed to hold photovoltaic panels. The remaining space acts as barrel storage, a tasting room, and administrative offices.

Architecturally unique features blend well with conventional concrete, glass, and plaster finishes. CBC supplied the steel for this clear-span/hybrid western frame that utilized 2½-inch insulated metal roof and wall panels, leaving the structure with a clean finish. The exterior was covered in rusted Corten to provide a natural finish and complement the surrounding landscape.
