

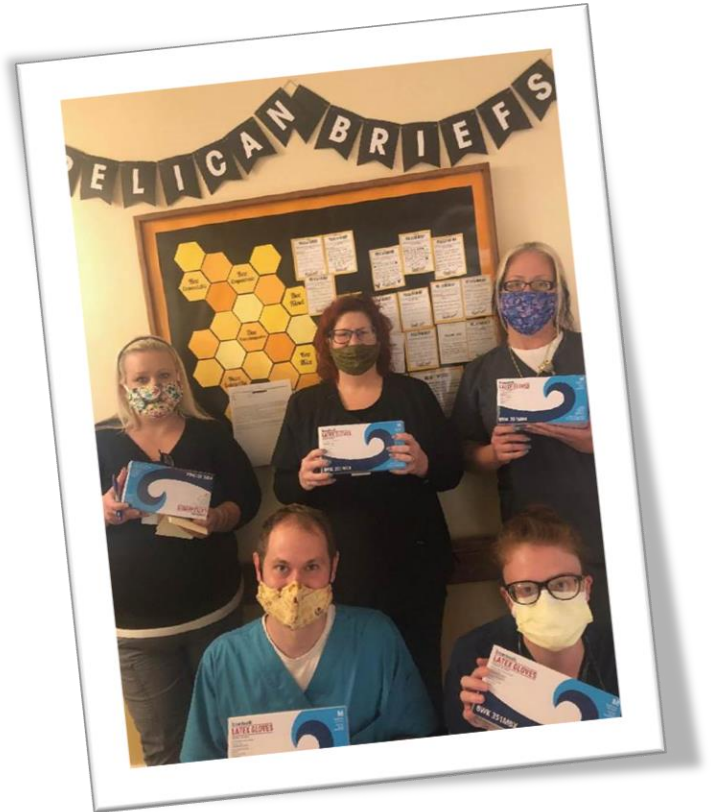

The division sent over supplies to the Bear River Health Department.

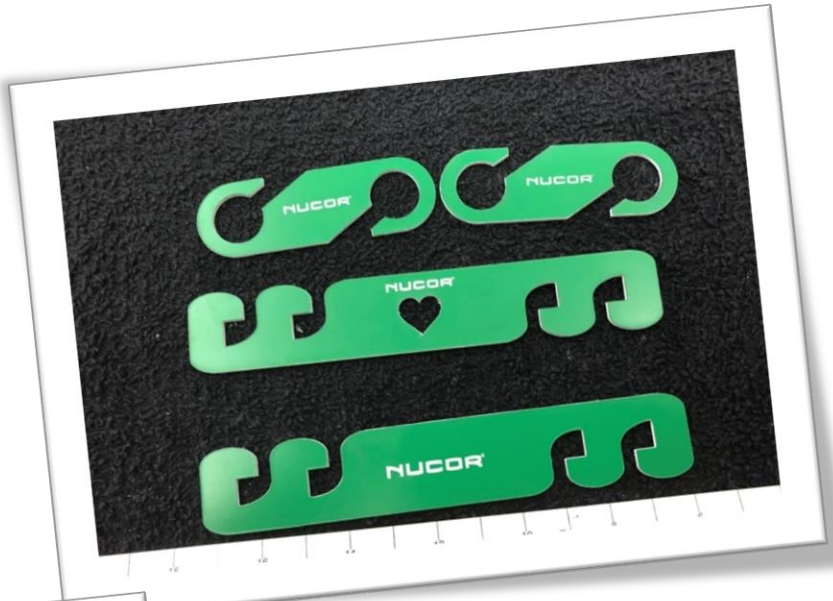
In total they sent:

Alabama

With the help of teammate Rocky Norton, and his dad, Gary Norton, the division was able to donate 250 flexible plastic mask holders to Pediatric Clinic LLC and East Alabama Medical Center in Auburn, AL to help the doctors and nurses there in one of the State of Alabama hotspots for the COVID-19 virus.
