Recreational Shade Structure

The City of Chico Bocce Ball Complex project in Chico, CA, is a recreational shade structure designed to support community engagement and outdoor leisure. The canopy spans 9,680 sf and features a single slope framing system with R-Panel roofing in Forest Green. Its structural steel and roof trim are finished in Aztec Blue, offering both durability and visual appeal.

This canopy provides shaded coverage for four regulation-size bocce ball courts, which were constructed by the Chico Area Recreation and Park District (CARD) as part of a broader initiative to expand recreational amenities for the community. The complex includes ADA-accessible pathways, benches, and landscaping, creating a welcoming and inclusive environment for players of all ages and abilities. The shade structure plays a key role in improving comfort and usability, especially during Chico's warmer months, and supports the departments mission to promote active lifestyles and community engagement.
